#### **HUNTER'S SAFETY COURSE**





## Taft Rotary Club learns about firearm advocacy


The activities of several firearms advocacy groups were the topic of last week's meeting of the Rotary Club. Rotarian Wes Morris, owner of Ten Percent Firearms in Taft, told of four groups active in the State's political activities relative to gun control. First was the National Rifle Association (NRA), while a nation-wide group, is very active in California in a number of areas including legislative

The California Rifle and Pistol Association (CRPA) focuses strictly on California in ways similar to the NRA. The Calguns Foundation promotes education for all stakeholders about firearms laws, rights, and privileges. The Second Amendment Foundation (SAF) is mainly an educational and legal action organization.

He said that there are very active programs of firearms education in the Taft area and the Central Valley leads the rest of the nation in fund-raising for this pur-

pose.

Morris said there was no gun legislation until about 1933 when prohibition brought the use of firearms to the forefront as rival gangs began shooting each

other. This prompted the first gun control laws. The Gun Control Act of 1968 was prompted by the assassination of Robert Kennedy. This prohibits the selling of firearms to certain categories of individuals.
