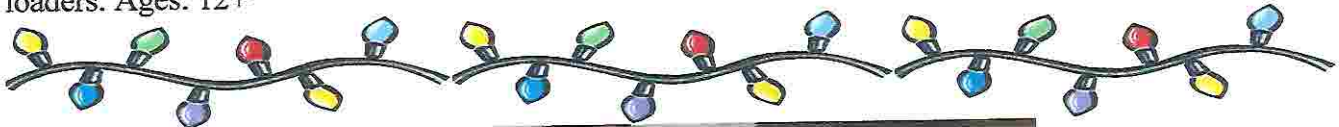


HUNTER'S SAFETY COURSE

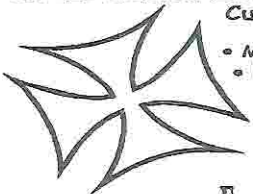

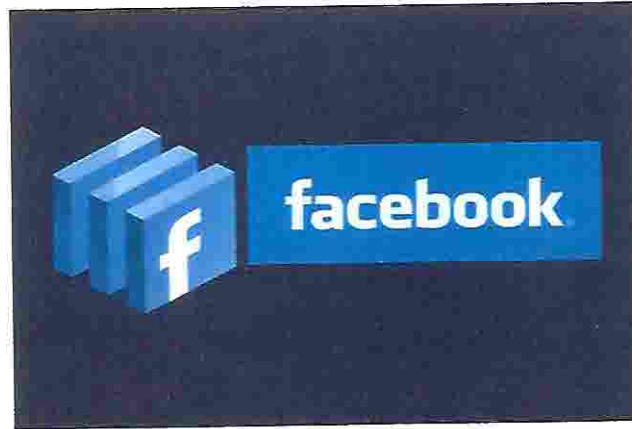
